open our doors to burgeoning women's health activists.







Advocacy For Access



WHS provided HIV Peer Educator Training Sessions, with 20 youth participants ages 19-29 years old, who received training on HIV, how to access services, get tested and treated, and refer to community resources. Together the youth addressed the misconceptions and stigma that surrounds HIV, and gained knowledge in a compassionate and supportive learning atmosphere.

WHS supported AB 775 The Reproductive FACT Act, SB 4 Health For All, SB 329 Comprehensive Sex Education and SB 23 to Repeal the Maximum Family Grant.
